

Dress Guidelines

1. Unless otherwise specified, shorts may be worn to all student ministry events permitted that the length of shorts worn are about a dollar bill length from the top of the knee cap and are no shorter than fingertip length
2. Skirts should also be of modest length. Skirts should meet the same requirements as shorts. No mini-skirts. When in doubt about the length, wear something else.
3. Tank tops can be worn as long as the width of the band/strap is at least 2 Inches and it is not low cut. Any shirts that expose the stomach or back are not allowed. Please also note that shirts that expose these two areas when a student stretches or bends over are too short and are also not allowed.
4. Low cut shirts are not permitted. Please also be mindful of what is exposed when bending over.
5. Whenever an event calls for a swim suit, girls are required to wear a modest one piece swim suit or a modest tankini. If a tankini is worn, the top must come all the way down to the bottom. No stomach exposed. Bottoms must have full back coverage; no string bottoms permitted. If you are in doubt, please see the handout for examples or talk to Ashley.
6. Shirts with offensive logos, alcohol or tobacco logos or any other material that might be a bad representation of Jesus Christ or Lake Norman Baptist Church are not allowed.
7. All clothing must cover all undergarments. Therefore, shirts and pants should be worn that do not expose these, even if it meets the other requirements.
8. Please be mindful of tight clothing. Please do not wear excessively tight clothes.

Finally, remember that everything we do should be as unto Jesus Christ (Colossians 3:23). This dress code is not intended to do anything but provide a godly boundary for our dress, so that our witness to a world that desperately needs Jesus Christ is both harmless and blameless (Philippians 2:15). In some cases, an event or mission trip may require a more stringent dress code, which is mandatory to follow for that particular situation. The overall goal at anytime for our student ministry is to be decent and modest in our dress (I Timothy 2:9).
